

**NAME**

CURLOPT\_PASSWORD – password to use in authentication

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_PASSWORD, char *pwd);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass a char \* as parameter, which should be pointing to the zero terminated password to use for the transfer.

The *CURLOPT\_PASSWORD(3)* option should be used in conjunction with the *CURLOPT\_USERNAME(3)* option.
