

Important Browser Information

When you do any programming language that is used on the Internet you will need to constantly re-load web pages. The problem comes when your browser can't do a forced reload. What happens is when you click the refresh button in internet explorer or click the reload button in netscape navigator it re-loads the page from memory so your not really re-loading the page. This is a disaster when programming but, there is a solution. Only netscape navigator has a way to do a **forced reload**. You do it by holding down the shift key and clicking the reload button. If internet explorer has a way to do it I'm not familiar with it so email if you know of one. You will need to download netscape navigator, "if you don't already have it", so you can do a forced reload of you programming work. I recommend that you download version 4.7x because the newest version to this date has bugs in it. You can get it by going here:
