Why should you use PDF files?

By using PDF files, you can:

Save Time

Print jobs have a lead time of days or weeks ... PDF files have a lead time of minutes! **That Rocks!**

Save Money

Compare the cost of the U.S. Mail with that of e-mailing a PDF file, or posting it on the web. **Wow!**

Increase Functionality

Do your paper Catalogs and Brochures have a Find function? Or links to your web site? **Nope!**

Improve Compatibility

PDF files can be viewed on nearly every platform that exists ... with the Free Acrobat Reader.
Can your presentation or slide-show software do that? **No Way!**

Increase Reliability

In PDF form, your documents will always look the way you intended ... on every platform.
Can HTML say that? **Not a Chance!**

Enhance Security

PDF files can have multiple levels of customizable, password-protected security controls. **Cool!**

Why should you use PDF Magic?

We Love Acrobat ... but using it to create interactive PDFs can be a big PAIN!

Suppose you wanted to have a web link (to your home page) on each of 64 pages in your catalog.

Without PDF Magic, you would put the URL on a Master Page in your source document, & distill. Then you would open the PDF in Acrobat, & use the Link tool to build the link on pg. 1. Then you would repeat that process 63 more times. Each by hand, with no precise measurements for size or placement. **Not me, thanks!**

With PDF Magic, you would put a Link Graphic for the URL on a Master Page in your source document, with precise control of size and placement. Then distill into a PDF. That's it. All the links are there and active. **Cool!**

Suppose you need to revise or update your catalog.

Without PDF Magic, you would make the changes, distill to PDF, and start making the links all over again. **Rats!**

With PDF Magic, you would make the changes, and distill. That's it. The links are still there from before. **Neat!**

Suppose you wanted to have cool transitions in your PDF file, like this one has.

Without PDF Magic, you would have to buy an expensive plug-in for Acrobat (IF you have the right OS, and IF you have the right version of Acrobat.) Once you distill, you'd add them page by page. **Bummer!**

With PDF Magic, you would put them in the source document, and forget about them. Distill & there they are. Should you make revisions (to the source doc.), and re-distill, no worries. They'll still be there. **Excellent!**

We could go on ... but we're sure you get the idea.
