What's New

If you are upgrading from a previous version of Heybaby you may be interested in knowing what is new in this version. In this version, we are happy to introduce the following new features and improvements:

1. **NEW**-Added tabs to the 'Today' view for 'Today', 'Trimester' and 'Notes'.
2. **NEW**-The notes tab allows you to record daily notes throughout your pregnancy. A button to the right on the note tab allows you to view a list of all notes that have been entered.
3. **NEW** – A Chinese birthing chart has been added to the library selection. This tool has been used for hundreds of years to determine if baby will be a boy or girl.
4. **NEW** – Added the ability to move forward / backward a day at a time in the Today view. If you missed the information about your baby's development from the prior day, you can now move back and see what was said for that day.
5. **NEW** – Within the Day Calculator you can now navigate to any specific day and click the 'Today View' button to see additional details for that day.
6. **NEW**- Ovulation Calculator. This tool will allow you to more easily determine the ideal dates in which fertility is at its peak. In addition, this feature will also estimate the due date should pregnancy occur on the ovulation date.
7. **NEW**– Glossary of Pregnancy terms. As requested by our customers, we have now added a comprehensive list of almost 100 terms and definitions.
8. **NEW** – Improved support for PalmOS5® and Pocket PC's! Now Heybaby can be enjoyed on almost any popular handheld computing device.
9. **Added Library** – Some functionality has been moved (and added) to the new Library option. This tool allows more logical and easy access to reference information.
10. **Enhanced** - Improved graphic images.

Introduction

Welcome to Heybaby! Keeping track of your pregnancy's progress couldn't be easier. That's because Heybaby takes the guesswork out of keeping track of your baby's progress. Heybaby has several features that make this process even more enjoyable.

Features

- **Today view** - Shows baby's current development progress and pregnancy status and includes the ability to record daily notes. Today view **Includes:** Estimated due date, conceive date, last period, days till due date, day number, current date, daily messages of encouragement and information and a graphic image approximating your baby's current development stage.
- **Ovulation Calculator**- This tool will allow you to more easily determine the ideal dates in which fertility is at its peak. In addition, this feature will also estimate the due date should pregnancy occur on the ovulation date.
- **Glossary of Pregnancy terms** - As requested, we have added a comprehensive list of almost 100 terms and definitions complete with partial word search capability.
- **Chinese Birthing Chart** – This tool allows you to estimate if your baby will be a boy or a girl. Some say the accuracy of this tool to be between 93-99% percent.
- **Day Calculator** - Ability to see where your pregnancy will be on a given date.
- **Baby Name List** – over 1500 baby names with tools to help you locate names quickly.
- **Baby Name Favorites** - Keep track of your favorite names.
- **Growth Chart** - Identifies the week, approx. baby weight/length during development.
- **Wives Tales** - 40 Wives Tales (Registered Version Only)
- **Profile setup**- that allows you to specify the information that you know (Due Date, LMP or Conceive Date). Based on what you enter, the program will calculate the rest!
- **Print Favorite Name List or Today View** - using Palm ReDirector or PalmPrint you can print to either a Windows printer (via Serial cradle/cable) or to an IrPrinter. Print capability is only supported on the PalmOS® platform. PocketPC printing is not currently supported.
- **The Great Waggy**- A fun numerology calculator.

INSTALLATION

Heybaby will work on any PalmOS device that is running PalmOS Version 3.0 or higher (now including PalmOS® 5). To install Heybaby, follow these easy instructions:

Manual Installation (PalmOS® only)

1. Unzip the downloaded file (Heybaby.zip)
2. Double-click on the file called "Heybaby.prc" (this is the program). Click "Done" on the PalmOS install tool.
3. Double-click on the file called "BabyNDB.pdb" (this is the Name Database). Click "Done" on the PalmOS install tool.
4. HotSync your Palm device by setting it in the cradle that came with it and click the HotSync button on the cradle.
5. That's it!

Heybaby Installer (PalmOS® and PocketPC's)

1. Download the Heybaby installer.
2. Run 'Setup.exe'
3. Follow the installation prompts (HotSync if using a PalmOS® device to install to your handheld).
4. Click the Finish button.

Heybaby Installer (Pocket PC)

1. Download the Heybay installer.
2. Run 'Setup.exe'
3. Click 'Next' on the first prompt.
4. Click 'I Agree' if you agree to the license agreement.
5. Click 'Next'.
6. Connect your Pocket PC to your computer.
7. Click 'Start Install' to begin the installation to your Pocket PC.
8. Click 'OK'.
9. Please wait until the baby name database has been transferred. This transfer can take 2-5 min.



Getting Started

The first thing you will want to do is setup your Profile. This allows Heybaby to track your progress throughout your pregnancy. To begin the setup, click the lower-right Icon on the main screen and following these steps:

1. To the right of the prompt that states "I Know", select the information that you know. Such as "1st Day of Last Period", "Due Date" or the "Date Conceived".
2. Next, click on the dashed box to the right of "is/was on:" prompt to select the date for the above known information.
3. Keep in mind, if the year is different from the current year, be sure to click the ">" arrow at the top of the Calendar first. Then select the month and tap the day of the month.
4. After completing step #3 above, you'll see the calculated dates for the Estimated Due Date, Last Period and Conceived date.
5. Next, if you plan to print any of the options that are Print-enabled select the appropriate print device. PalmPrint will use Steven's Creek software or ReDirector (one of our favorites) will allow direct Serial to your PC's printer if you have also ReDirector for PalmOS running on your Desktop PC.
6. Clicking "Auto start today" will start the "Today" view automatically when the program is launched, but only if you have registered the program. Trial versions ignore this setting.
7. Once completed, click the "Save Profile" button.
8. That's it! You shouldn't have to go through all these steps unless you want to use a different print device or your Due Date needs to be adjusted.



Today View

Tapping the "Today" icon from the main screen will display important pregnancy status information, including:

- Week Number
- Estimated Due Date
- Conceived Date
- Last Period Date
- Number of Days Till Due
- Current Day Number
- Current Trimester
- Notations on pregnancy/baby's progress
- Trimester Date ranges
- Graphic image approximating the baby's current stage of development

Feature Diagram

The following diagram is a quick reference of features available within the Today view. Notice the middle white button to the right. If at anytime you want to return to today's date (after moving forward / back using the green arrows) you can click here and select 'Today'. You can also easily navigate to any date in the pregnancy.





PRINTING

If you would like to print a hard copy of the text contents of this screen, click the "Menu" icon on your Palm device and select the "Print" and "Today" menu option. If you are using ReDirector, you'll be asked to set the Palm in the HotSync cradle. If using PalmPrint, point the IrDA port of your Palm Device towards your Ir-Enabled printer (Infra-Red Printer).



BEAM DEMO

If you would like to Beam the Demo to another Palm user, select the menu option "Help", "Beam Demo". Point the two Ir-ports on each Palm device towards each other from approx. 2 feet apart. Tap "Yes" to Beam the Demo and wait to allow the receiving Palm user accept the program. Once this is done, select "Yes" a second time to beam the Names database to the user.



RETURNING TO MAIN

To return to the Main screen, tap the Left Arrow at the Top of the screen or take the Menu option "View", "Main".



Library

The library option allows a quick and efficient means of accessing reference information. Simply select the book of interest and you will be taken to that function.



Pregnancy Glossary

Heybaby includes a glossary of almost 100 pregnancy related terms and definitions (this list was provided by our friends at All About Moms - <http://www.allaboutmoms.com>). You can easily search for a specific term by typing any portion of the word and click the search icon (🔍). You can click this button repeatedly to search for additional occurrences within the list. You may also simply click a word to reveal the meaning in the bottom window. To go back one character, click the “⬅” button. To clear your entry, click “🧼” the button.

🏠 RETURNING TO MAIN

To return to the Main screen, tap the Left Arrow at the Top of the screen.

Wives Tales

Tap the Book icon in the middle-top row of images in on the Main screen. You will see the Read me page and Page 1. Be sure to read the "Read me" page and note that all information contained within the Wives Tales is simply not true and should not be taken seriously. It was added to this application because so many people find them interesting.

To navigate the Wives Tales, you have two methods of navigating. Tap the Left/Right arrow keys at the top left/right of each page to move a page at a time. Optionally, you may tap the upper-right on the down arrow beside "Page" to quickly browse to any page within the book.

RETURNING TO MAIN

To return to the Main screen, tap the Left Arrow at the Top of the screen.

Baby Name Ideas

Heybaby includes a list of over 1500 Baby names. Most of those names also include meanings, origins and popularity ranking (Provided by the Social Security Administration). To access this list, tap the upper-right icon that states "Baby Name" ideas

***NOTE-** If you see a Grid without any names, be sure to install the file "BabyNDB.PDB" and HotSync it to your Palm.

NAVIGATING NAMES

Navigating the names is very easy, but may not be as obvious at first glance. To jump to a series of names that begin with a particular letter, tap that letter from the list of letters at the top of the screen. You may optionally tap more than one letter if you want to "Drill-Down" into a more specific list of names. For instance, to look for names that are "JOHN"-Like, tap in J-O-H. The program will then being to show you a list of names that match those same first three letters.

Paging Up/Down - Select a name from the Grid and press the Up/Down arrow buttons on your Palm to page up/down through the list.

 **Clearing Search Field** - To Erase the name/filter, click the small eraser-like icon (left of heart). This will clear the filter/search box and allow you to tap in a different name.

 **Searching a specific Name** - If you know a specific name, the quickest way to locate it is to use Graffiti to "Tap" it in. Once the name has been tapped in, click the "Magnify Glass" icon to search. If the name is found it will be displayed, otherwise the next closest match will be displayed.

 **Backup One Character** - To clear the last character in the Search Field, tap the icon immediately to the right of the filter window that looks like "<<".

 **Details** - To get Additional information on a name, tap the name and click the "Details" button. This screen will show you additional information about the selected name. If you would like to add this name to your favorite list, tap the Heart Icon. To return to the Baby Name list, click the Left-Arrow at the top of the screen.

 **Adding/Showing Favorites** - If you would like to add a new Favorite or Show your Favorite List, Tap the "Heart" icon. You will next be prompted to select "Add as Favorite" or "Show Favorites". Select the option you wish to perform. If you select "Add as Favorite", the currently selected name will be added to your favorite list. The Show Favorites will allow you to view, Add, Remove or change any information about the names you have selected. Keep in mind, this Favorite list is kept separate from the main Baby Name list. This will allow future potential upgrades of the Baby Name list to not interfere with your custom created list of Favorite names.

 **Picking a Random Name** - Sometimes it might be useful to just let the computer pick a random name. To do this, click the button at the top of the screen "RND". The program will then pick a different name from the list and select it. This is a great way to browse names that you might normally have never seen!

 **Printing Favorites** - If you would like to print a hard copy of your Favorite baby names, select the menu option "Output", "Print Favorites". If you are using ReDirector, you'll be asked to set the Palm in the HotSync cradle. If using PalmPrint, point the IrDA port of your Palm Device towards your Ir-Enabled printer (Infra-Red Printer).

Saving Favorites to Memo pad - If you would like to save your Favorite baby names to the Memo Pad (Built-In Memo application), select the option "Output", "Export Memo". The name list will then show up in the Memo Pad application.

RETURNING TO MAIN

To return to the Main screen, tap the Left-Arrow at the top of the screen.

Favorite Names

If you have added any new baby names while browsing the Baby Name list, you can easily view your list of favorite names within this feature. You can also add names to the list that may not be included in the name list we provided. This feature allows you to quickly glance at the list of baby names that you have picked out for your baby.

Chinese Birthing Chart

The Chinese birthing chart is said to have been found in a royal tomb of a Chinese scientist near Peking, China. The original copy is kept in the Institute of Science of Peking. The accuracy of the chart has been proved by thousands of People and is believed to be 99 percent accurate. By drawing a line from the woman's age at conception to the month of conception the chart will identify if the baby is going to be a boy or a girl. While the accuracy is said to be very high, please do not use this chart to determine what color to paint the baby's room ☺ This tool is mean for a reference, estimation and entertainment only.

To use this feature, simply add 9 months to the mother's age at conception and select this age from the drop-down list. Next, select the month of conception. Once both selections have been made, click the 'Click Here!' button to determine if the baby is going to be a boy or a girl.

CBC 

Add 9 months to your age at conception and use that value as your age. Then select the month of conception. Some say this chart is 93% accurate (or higher).

DayCalc

If you would like to know your pregnancy information for a specific date, tap the "DayCalc" icon in the lower right of the Main screen. Next, click the dashed date to bring up the Date selector. Select the Year, Month and Day that you would like to calculate. You will then see your pregnancy information for the specified date. This information will include the following:

- Week # (From Last Period)
- Week # (From Conceive)
- Days till Due Date
- Days since Last Period
- Days since Conception
- Trimester on that Date
- Trimester Date Ranges (1st-3rd Trimesters)

You can also click the **Today View** button to view the calculated date in the Today View window. This window will show you an estimated size of the baby plus additional daily text information about the baby's development stage.

RETURNING TO MAIN

To return to the Main screen, tap the Left-Arrow at the top of the screen.



Growth

After properly setting up your Profile you can use the "Growth" icon from the main screen to see approximately how far along your baby has developed. The Week, Weight and Length will be automatically highlighted based on the current Week number. Keep in mind that this information is based on averages.



RETURNING TO MAIN

To return to the Main screen, tap the Left-Arrow at the top of the screen.

Questions/Answers

Q: Why did WAGWARE develop this program?

A: We are expecting a little one too. We found few applications for the Palm existed to assist couples wanting to track their pregnancy. In fact, we found none. Most applications we came across would calculate a due date, but that was about the extent of it. Heybaby was developed to provide information throughout the pregnancy as well as provide useful tools that are likely to be used dozens of times over the next 40 weeks.

Q: Do you plan on enhancing this program?

A: If bugs are found, we'll fix them as quickly as we can! We are also very open to suggestions for improving Heybaby; please send your requests to support@wagware.com. We'll do our best to accommodate any ideas for improving our product!

Q: How does Heybaby calculate the week numbers?

A: It's all based on a 280-day calculation or 40 weeks. Based on our research, this is what most doctors use to calculate your due date. So, we developed the program around this methodology. The 40 weeks starts from the first day of your last menstrual cycle and continues for the next 280 days.

Q: Where did you get your Baby Name List?

A: We contacted the Social Security Administration and asked them if it would be ok to publish their list of Baby Names and Rankings within our software which they graciously allowed us to. So, we started here and began searching through dozens of Baby name books trying to find Meanings and Origins. All Meanings and Origins were typed in manually. Please notify us (sales@wagware) of any typo's if any are found, many late nights were spent entering this information but we did our best to minimize/eliminate them before publicly posting Heybaby.

Q: Where can I register Heybaby?

A: You can register from the partner website where you downloaded this copy of Heybaby or our website at <http://www.wagware.com>. In either case, please be sure to include your HotSync name. It is required for registration!

How To Register

Registering Heybaby is easy. When you first tap on the icon to load Heybaby trial screen will either indicate how many days are remaining on your trial or if it has **expired**. In either case, make notice of your HotSync name which is identified between two single-quotes ('). In the screenshot below, the HotSync name is 'Emulator'. Your HotSync ID will be the name you used when you first setup your Palm. Whatever appears here, please record and use this when registering Heybaby.



You can register your copy of Heybaby directly on the WAGWARE Website by opening your browser and going to <http://www.wagware.com>. From here, you will find instructions on where to click to pay for and receive your registration code.

Once you have received your registration code, tap the **Register** button and simply tap the registration code exactly as you received it into the **Registration Screen**.
